Just enough people turned out to make this an official CDMC hike! Three members enjoyed a 13.6 km hike from Nymph Falls to Comox Dam & back again. Trilliums, bleeding-heart, calypso orchids , salmonberry, Oregon grape & yellow violets continue to bloom in the woods, and parasitic plants such as coralroot & pinesap are starting to emerge. Birds included Common Mergansers & Harlequin ducks in the river , and Pacific Wrens , flickers & other woodpeckers in the woods. New birds singing were Townsend's Warblers & Hammond's Flycatchers .

Total time 4.5 hrs with 125m cumulative elevation gain.
