As there is so much snow this year we ascended via the Rousseau route, which turned out to be almost completely clear of snow. The ridge is gained in about an hour and from there to the summit there are great views all around and especially across to Arrowsmith.

Another party came up the Saddle route, so we were able to get information on the snow conditions there, and decided to descend that way. It was good boot skiing snow, and one member demonstrated a fine ice axe arrest!


